












ALPINE SAUNA

Enjoy the alpine Spa vibe next to the day lounge in the cosy cocoon of the Bridge Deck sauna. The sauna is accentuated by glass doors to feel open, while soft woods, fibre optic lighting and stone walls lit from above make a warm and inviting interior.



Up on Bridge Deck, the aft-facing outdoor space can be fully enclosed with bifold doors to create a 33 square-metre Sky Lounge (355 sq ft) with skylight. With fabulous views, the inside-outside feeling is enhanced with the rippled ceiling effect reminiscent of reflections on water. H2 created a contemporary modern palette, with bold marble choices and reflective surfaces.

INTERIORS

Our SeaXplorer 60 general arrangement features 347 square metres of luxury interiors (3,735 sq ft), plus another 33 square metres (355 sq ft) for the fully-enclosed Bridge Deck Sky Lounge with glass doors.

UPPER DECK LOUNGE AND DINING

Stepping inside on Upper Deck, the 60 square-metre Lounge and Dining (645 sq ft) is a haven of soft comfort, artwork and detailed finishes. H2's layout is comfortable, even cosy, while keeping a bit of formality and design pedigree. Rounded forms and organic shapes bring a cosy balance to the masculine exteriors. With exceptionally high comfort and low noise and vibrations, the only reminder that you are on a highly capable expedition platform is the stunning view outside.



OWNERS SUITE

The full-beam Owners Suite on Main Deck is expressive and


personal with luxurious fabrics, decorative leather and warm woods. The curved headboard provides a grand entrance that playfully draws you around the space – an effect amplified in the soft oval ceiling dome. Portside is a private lounge and starboard an office – while mirrors slide open to reveal the walkthrough dressing and bathroom.

Forward on Main Deck, the Owners Suite, His and Hers Dressings and Bathroom total 67 square metres (720 sq ft).





Her hybrid power generation system with a battery bank powers two electrical propulsion motors for an economical and environmentally friendly configuration. A private yacht for family and friends, the Owners selected Carlo Torre of Monaco Yacht Temptation to create a unique interior design.



INTERIOR DESIGN

To create the interiors, the Owner selected designer Vasiliy Shprits, the architect behind all of the Tinkoff Collection LA DATCHA properties. Throughout the yacht's interior, there are hints of inspirational folk tales. For example the Russian folk tale about the man who had to pass through fire, water and copper pipes to save the girl he loved. This little 'Russian touch' can be found, for example, in the Main Salon where fire is literally featured in the dining table's fire pits, water is recalled through the bar counter's ice top feature and the coffee table's frozen liquid style and bronze detailing has been added throughout as an ode to the copper pipes.





CROW'S NEST AND BRIDGE DECK

The top of the boat, the Crow's Nest, offers spectacular vistas. Take the stairs down and emerge in the 115 square-metre (1,238 sq ft) indoor-outdoor Sky Lounge with whirlpool. Forward, the wheelhouse is the expedition hub. Extended enclosed bridge wings provide the crew sightlines.





The SeaXplorer 60 Hybrid system uses PTO/PTI technology in combination with battery bank power. Multiple sources of energy work together seamlessly, ensuring the highest efficiency throughout a wide operating profile. You reduce harmful emissions, reduce noise and vibrations while benefiting from lower fuel and maintenance costs.

- 5,000 nautical miles range at 12 knots cruising speed, maximum speed 14.5 knots
- Fuel capacity of 188,000 litres (49,664 gallons)

HYBRID POWER AND PERFORMANCE

REDUCING HARMFUL EMISSIONS

We are the industry leader in Selective Catalytic Reduction (SCR) filters that slash harmful NOx emissions by 70 percent. In your SeaXplorer Hybrid system, both your main engines as well as the generator sets operate SCR filters with full transatlantic range (5,000 nautical miles), complying with the most stringent International Maritime Organization requirements for unrestricted global cruising. We also use exhaust gas soot filters on generators for cleaner emissions.

HAPPY ENGINES THANKS TO HYBRID POWER

Your yacht's engines are happiest running at a consistent 80-90 percent load – burning fuel efficiently with a lean mixture. The SeaXplorer Hybrid system applies the optimum number of engines running at optimum load with batteries to absorb fluctuations in demand – for example peak demands from your air-conditioning, galley or bow thruster. With a steady optimum load, you avoid unnecessary engine load fluctuations and unnecessary starts and stops, so your engines burn fuel efficiently while wear and tear decreases. You save fuel and maintenance costs.

The process of completing your SeaXplorer starts at one of Damen's hull building yards. Under the supervision of our project management team, the craftsmen and women at our specialists yards assemble the steel and aluminium before the hull hits the water for the first time and the outfitting phase begins.

MATERIALS

- Steel hull with scantlings, welds, plating and stiffeners engineered by Damen Yachting for minimum noise and vibrations, with Ice Class steel ice belt
- Aluminium and steel superstructure
- Faired and painted to perfection with the highest acceptance criteria in modern, climate and humidity controlled covered facilities
- Teak decks with first class grade quarter sawn 55-mm (visible) wide teak



The certified helideck also permits operations during charter and commercial use.



The SeaXplorer 60 complies with the International Maritime Organization's Polar Code, a set of safety and environmental regulations in force since January 2017 for all vessels entering Arctic and Antarctic waters. The Polar Code is applicable (in general) above 60° north and below 60° south (see illustration). Even small changes in polar winds and currents can quickly lead to your yacht being surrounded by close pack ice, which can be very dangerous for yachts without extra strengthening.




